**PRESS RELEASE: LOU HOLTZ PRAISES JUDGE AMY  
BARRETT'S NOMINATION**

Today, legendary football coach Lou Holtz gave his seal of approval to Judge Amy Barrett, President Trump's nominee to the Supreme Court. In a video statement released by Senator Tom Cotton's "Supreme Court War Room," Holtz called Judge Barrett a "fantastic judge and a great legal mind." Holtz also noted that Judge Barrett studied and taught at the University of Notre Dame, the same school that Holtz coached to a football national championship in 1988.

Lou Holtz is a member of the College Football Hall of Fame, and is the only college football coach to lead six different schools to bowl games. During his coaching career, Holtz led the University of Arkansas and the University of Notre Dame, among others. In 1983, Holtz was elected to the Arkansas Sports Hall of Fame. In 2011, the University of Notre Dame also awarded Holtz an honorary doctor of laws degree. Earlier this year, President Trump also announced that he intends to award Holtz the Presidential Medal of Freedom in recognition of his decades of coaching, education, and charity work.

Judge Amy Coney Barrett was nominated by President Trump to the Supreme Court on September 26, 2020. Her confirmation hearing in the Senate Judiciary Committee is scheduled to begin on Monday, October 12, 2020.
