### KEY FACTS

- Nominated by President Trump to the Supreme Court on Sept. 26, 2020
- Strong supporter of the Constitution
- Believes judges should rule based on the law as written, not legislate from the bench
- Has served as a judge on the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit since 2017
- Impeccable legal credentials, judicial record, character, and temperament

- Earned her B.A., *magna cum laude*, from Rhodes College

- Clerked for two federal judges, including Justice Scalia on the Supreme Court
- Practiced law at a D.C. law firm
- Taught constitutional law & other courses at Notre Dame Law School for 15 years
